Dear Friend,

All fundraising carried out at Hathersage Swimming Pool or in aid of is for The King George's Field Charity. This charity was set up in 1936 as part of a national scheme to commemorate the death of King George V.

Why do we need you to support the Pool? It makes the village very special, being situated in a beautiful setting and it provides a fantastic, family-friendly facility for people of all ages to have fun and keep fit. We need to preserve it for future generations so that your children and grandchildren will enjoy the benefit from it in the future. We would stress that King George's Field Charity is raising money for the long-term maintenance and refurbishment of the pool infrastructure including the installation of a photovoltaic glass roof on the Solarium. Money raised is **not** used for the routine running and maintenance costs.

We have hard-working marketing and fundraising groups which organise special events during the year and we hope you will support us at all or some of these. As usual we will be holding our Monthly night swims to live music and The Annual 24 hour Swim. There is also two fundraising schemes we would like you to consider, the Patrons Scheme and the 100 Club.

**Patron's Scheme:**

The Patrons Scheme has been running since 2011, bringing valuable financial support to the Pool. Patrons can join for just one year, paying just £50 per year and can continue being a Patron for as long as they like. They would, subject to their approval, have their names displayed in the noticeboard outside the Pool and will be invited to a Patrons event on during the season, where they can be involved in discussions to formulate a 10 year plan.

If you, or anyone you know, would like to donate or continue to donate under this scheme please complete the Patron's form overleaf and return it with your cheque for £50 to the address shown. If you are able to complete the Gift Aid declaration it would be appreciated as it will enable us to claim an additional amount from the Inland Revenue.

**100 Club:**

The 100 Club has been running for 11 years, again providing financial support for the pool, and also a monthly prize draw for participants. At a cost of £12 per year (November - October), pro-rata if you join now, you may win back your contribution.
